Conditions of Entry and General Information

**ALL COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS MUST BE RETURNED TO
HARRISON & HETHERINGTON LTD.
Borderway Mart, Rosehill, Carlisle CA1 2RS**

1. All sheep entered must carry an MV Accredited Status. The categories of sheep offered for sale will be as defined on the entry form.
2. All female sheep **MUST BE FULLY REGISTERED** and all male sheep to be fully registered **or** birth notified and thereby eligible for full registration with the Texel Sheep Society.
3. All Lamb Rams to be bred by exhibitor and to be entered under the relevant exhibitor's flock code.
4. **IDENTIFICATION: Tagging** – all sheep must be double tagged with official Texel Sheep Society tags which comply with Government legislation. The vendor shall be responsible for the correctness of identity. Any tags which are tampered with, handwritten/bear marks, are faulty or illegible will be rejected from the sale.
5. If any animal offered for sale has semen or embryos collected from it, or used as a sire, the vendor must declare this on the sales entry form and is solely responsible for checking the sales catalogue entry and reporting any omission to the club prior to the inspection taking place. Failure to do so will exclude the sheep from the sale.
The Texel Sheep Society reserves the right to blood sample and/or archive DNA from any sheep and/or take wool samples for forensic testing.
By entering the respective sales, all vendors are agreeing to abide by the Society's conditions or entry and conditions of sale, on the entry form. All entry forms to be signed by the vendor.
All sheep entries must clearly show whether the animal is single, twin, triplet, quad ETC or ET and this information to be clearly shown in the sale catalogue.
6. Scrapie Genotyping is no longer mandatory. If the Scrapie Genotype is declared in the sale catalogue or at point of sale and subsequently found to be incorrect, for whatever reason, the purchaser shall have the right to return the animal and to claim the full purchase price from the vendor.
7. Members are reminded it is against the Auctioneers rules and regulations and the Society Bye-laws for **ANY** rejected sheep to then be sold on the Auctioneers premises. The decision of the inspector shall be final. Adult sheep entered must be bare clipped after 1st April each year.
8. All full Registration Certificates must accompany the completed entry form. Ram Dockets will be issued by the Texel Society.
9. **Entry Fees** - A fee of £12 per head will be charged on all entries (£10 + VAT). Cheques to be made payable to Harrison & Hetherington Ltd. and must accompany the completed entry form. Entry fees are non-refundable.
10. All sheep forward for sale will be subject to a Veterinary Inspection. The decision of the Inspectors will be final and any animal failed will be removed from the sale and forfeit the entry fee. Entry fees are non-refundable.
11. Substitute entries will be accepted, one per section per vendor. For First Sale all substitutes to be notified to the office by Monday 30th August.

Acceptance of Stock: Due to DEFRA regulations the arrival of stock can only be accepted onto the market premises within the time period stated in the sale catalogue. Any alteration will be notified to all vendors, however we request that all arrival times must be strictly adhered to when published in the catalogue.
